## Perspectives to the current circumstances

## Proposal: "100 climate neutral cities by 2030, by and for the citizens"



- The Mission Board for climate neutral and smart cities proposes that the EU Commission should:
  - Establish a mission that will support and promote 100 European cities in their systemic transformation towards climate-neutrality by 2030
- Build a multi-level, co-creative process formalised through a Climate City Contract - that is adjusted to the realities of each city while contributing to the overall goal of the mission;
  - Promote these cities as national, European and global frontrunners in addressing the European Green Deal and its headline goal of climate neutrality in Europe by 2050,
  - · Inspiring many more cities in doing so;
  - Bring about a just transition by helping to deliver on the UN's Agenda 2030 and its Sustainable Development Goals to improve citizens' wellbeing;
  - Bring associated benefits such as improve air quality, creating jobs, promoting healthier lifestyles, improving mobility

#### Five key enablers to push transition



- 1. Plan a transformative agenda to become innovation hubs
- 2. Develop new forms of participative governance
- 3. Develop a new economic model for climate action
- 4. Put in place an integrated urban planning model
- 5. Deploy and use smart systems and data platforms

#### The Climate City Contract (CCC)



- Support, promote and showcase 100 European cities to make a systemic transformation towards climate neutrality by 2030, and to make these cities experimentation and innovation hubs for all cities
- Offer cities financial means to achieve the mission goals through Horizon Europe and other European funds

#### **Contracts to**

- Identify the policy and implementation gaps as a basis to inform a roadmap for transition
- Coordinate all stakeholders within the city towards a common climate goal
- Coordinate national and EU authorities to deliver the necessary legal, governance and financial necessary framework conditions
- Create a one-stop-shop for multi-level negotiations in order to facilitate city activities to make the transition reality

## **Digital Innovation for Sustainable Cities:**Cross-thematic Cluster Pilot

- Pilot action within the Urban Agenda for the EU
- Achieving the goal of sustainable and carbon-neutral urban development is, to large extend, dependent on the full utilization of digital opportunities in cities
- The Cluster Pilot gathers relevant theme Coordinators and Action Leaders to cross-fertilize and identify common issues on digitalization
- Funding for the one-year pilot is reserved from FI

Smart and digital is largely visible in various instruments, now also as Mission
