Sustainable energy Positive & zero cARbon CommunitieS demonstrates and validates technically and socioeconomically viable and replicable, innovative solutions for rolling out smart, integrated positive energy systems for the transition to a citizen centred zero carbon & resource efficient economy. SPARCS facilitates the participation of buildings to the energy market enabling new services and a virtual power plant concept, creating VirtualPositiveEnergy communities as energy democratic playground (positive energy districts can exchange energy with energy entities located outside the district). ## 1. INTRODUCTION

This deliverable, a list of events, is a working document that includes all relevant workshops, seminars, webinars, conferences etc. for SPARCS partners to pay attention to and coordinate their attendance and participation. The current deliverable D8.11 is an updated version of D8.10, representing the current state of play of the list of events.

#### 2. DESCRIPTION OF THE LIST OF EVENTS

The list of events focuses on events tracked by all consortium partners and includes relevant H2020 SCC1 and other applicable Smart Cities\Urban Planning\Urban Transformation focused events taking place in Europe. It is designed to enable the workflow of event identification and attendance.

The list of events to attend is managed by GOPA Com. with help from all WP8 and WP6 partners who are screening all relevant events Europe-wide. All tracked events are being analysed based on the audiences, scope and presentation type, thus allowing for a decision on how to be present at the event. The identified events are evaluated against their relevance in terms of target audiences, visibility potential and reach. The consortium partners who attend the event will follow with reporting and evaluation such as website article about the participation or sharing of knowledge presentation at the internal communications meetings.

The list of events to attend is built into an interactive working document that includes the following indicators:

- Name of the event
- Status: participation partners
- Partners who plan to attend
- Partners who attended
- Participation type
- Registration deadline
- Start and end date
- Organiser of the event
- Location of the event
- Link to the event
- Cost of participation
- Topic of the event
- Type of the event
- Target group of the event
- Audience number (reach)
- Partner nomination for attendance





A simplified form of these elements is also reflected online on the SPARCS website, displaying usually:

- Name of the event
- Location of the event
- Start and end date
- Link to the event
- Registration deadline

By doing this, we are ensuring wider targeted dissemination of closely related initiatives, thus boarding the multipliers reach.

WP8 leader GOPA Com. is requesting input on upcoming and past events from SPARCS partners during the monthly WP8 Communication coordination call or during the WP6 coordination call, thus allowing the list of events to be updated regularly. The tracking tool of events is added as appendix to this document.

#### 3. LIST OF EVENTS TO ATTEND

The working document - the list of events is uploaded and updated weekly\monthly on Microsoft Teams in WP8. GOPA Com tracks relevant events SPARCS objectives, including other H2020 projects, EU initiatives, EU institutions, and international events. To date, the document provides an overview of events identified in 2021 as well as identified potential events upcoming in 2022. The documents also contain information about past events starting from 2019.

#### 3.1 Summary of past events

Since the start of the project in 2019, SPARCs consortium partners have communicated and disseminated about SPARCS projects, its work and demonstrations in the seven cities during events on topics such as smart city communities, PED, stakeholder engagement and sustainable city development.





The events with the most outreach were Smart City Expo World Congress in November and the Smart and sustainable planning for cities and regions – SSPCR 2019 in December.

The start of the COVID-19 in early 2020 changed the events landscape significantly, as many events were cancelled or moved online. Nonetheless, SPARCs partners presented the project at 17 events during the year by distributing leaflets, attending conferences, and participating in one-to-one meetings with local companies and stakeholders, municipalities and cross-sectorial organisations. One of the most significant events in terms of outreach was the Covenant of Mayors Investment Forum – Energy Efficiency Finance Market Place in February 2020, with an audience of more than 500 people, mainly targeting municipalities. However, following the hits of the COVID-19 pandemic, the event attendance has been heavily impacted most of the project time.

Building on the experience of gathering input in 2020, GOPA Com. adapted the tracking tool in order to provide a more detailed overview of the events in 2021. This included requesting more detailed information on deadlines for submitting a presentation or putting forward plans to participate. However, the decision on participation in the events remains the responsibility of the partners, while GOPA Com is tasked with tracking potential opportunities and providing support to partners. In 2021, 111 events were tracked, out of which partners attended 79. The number could be attributed to digital fatigue linked to online format as well as overlapping timing, which means that sometimes partners need to choose which event to attend. Audience reach includes the scientific community, policymakers and H2020 stakeholders, and experts. Out of the total number of attended events, 28 events promoted SPARCs through a presentation on SPARCS by a partner, intervention in Q&A, panel contribution or events.

Amongst the events with broader outreach based on the available data were Eurocities 2021 in Leipzig in March, the Green Building Council Iceland's yearly conference in February, Business Environmental Day in June, and the Yearly Urban Planning Day in Iceland in December. Another combined physical and online event was a stakeholder workshop of the COST action on PEDs on 6-7th of October 2021, where Civiesco, VTT, CVUT and Kladno were actively organising and sharing insights from SPARCS. Also, research network events in Annex83 and in the COST action have reached large scientific focused audience, and learnings from SPARCS have already been shared in the several events organised in these research networks. SPARCS cities and technical partners have also been communicating about SPARCs on national and local level events, where the number of participants may have been smaller, yet, the impact and the sharing of local and national examples and experiences is recognised to have a high value. One of the notable examples is the All Ukrainian Home Owner Associations Forum in October, where LVIV, VTT took part to discuss climate-neutral cities and the role of homeowner associations in delivering them.

In addition, following the digital trend, GOPA Com organised four webinars promoting key topics for SPARCS, including SPARCS Replication webinar organised with Fraunhofer and BABLE in January 2021 where SPARCS Fellow cities Maia, Reykjavik, Kladno, Lviv and Kifissia were involved as speakers. The second webinar was SPARCS Business Models and Financing Mechanisms webinar organised with CiviESCo and KONE in April 2021. In October, GOPA organised with Suite5, and





Verd the SPARCS Evaluation Framework and Replication Considerations. Moreover, in the EU Green Week scope, GOPA organised the SPARCS webinar SPARCS City Vision Webinar in June 2021 together with SPI, Fraunhofer, the city of Espoo, the city of Kladno, the city of Kifissia as speakers. In the scope of the 19th European Week of Regions and Cities, GOPA, on behalf of SPARCS with fellow H2020 projects (Response and Pocityf), co-organised a workshop Fair and Inclusive citizens engagement for a new city vision in the energy transition. The three projects presented citizen engagement strategies to support the energy transition in cities. Kone and Kladno were also involved as speakers. The workshop took place in October 2021.

In addition, SPARCS partners presented the project at some of the most significant EU events, including EU Regions Week 2021. For example, SPARCS partners gave a presentation on the work done in Lviv within SPARCS was done at the session 'Positive Energy Districts as Innovation Ecosystems for climate-neutrality. A local SPARCS event was also planned during EU Mobility week in September.
